Southern Andaman, Hin Daeng, Hin Muang, Koh Haa and Phi Phi Islands for 3 days and 3 nights!

10 dives are included in this trip with the option of an extra 2 night dives and a visit to Phi Phi Don on the last night. The Scuba Explorer allows you to dive some beautiful dive sites in the Phi Phi National Marine Park and the Koh Lanta National Marine Park in style and comfort. There are sofas on the second deck both inside and outside, and on the top sundeck. These are often taken up with divers napping between each dive, but the size of the boat allows room enough for everyone, accommodating up to 22 guests.

A minivan will be available to collect you from Phuket airport or your hotel in Phuket and transfer you to Patong pier where the Scuba Explorer departs in the evening, traveling overnight and arriving in Phi Phi the next morning. It then arrives back at the pier on the 3rd day at 1:30pm where you will then get taken back to the airport or hotel. The delicious food is a mixture of western, Japanese and Thai and cooked everyday fresh on board by the excellent chef. The crew on this boat are very helpful and friendly, making sure you have everything you need to make your trip that bit more special, giving you a top experience both in and out of the water.

Food is served between each dive, with a snack bar of bread, jams, tea, fresh coffee, milo, cookies, candy and soft drinks available all day. Beer and wine are also included in the price so why not relax with a glass after your last dive of the day chatting with others about the wonderful days diving.

The Koh Lanta National Marine Park fee of 1,400thb is not included in the price and will be collected on the boat at the beginning of the trip.

The Things You Can See There!



The Dive Sites We Will Visit!

Hin Daeng and **Hin Muang** are so called because of the vibrant colours of the soft corals covering these dive sites. Red rock (Hin Daeng) and Purple rock (Hin Muang) are deep water pinnacles in pristine condition, home to some amazing marine life and known for its regular sightings of the graceful Manta Rays and Whale Sharks. But that's not all to see here, you will also encounter countless species of fish, shrimp and octopus. Reef sharks and Leopard sharks have also been seen here. The walls of these pinnacles are covered in soft corals, anemones and fan corals, host to a diverse amount of marine life. The pinnacles drop to depths of 60m and are surrounded by blue water giving an impressive backdrop for some stunning photos and videos.

Due to strong currents and deep depths these are recommended for advanced divers.

Explore the incredible caverns of **Koh Haa** and see the stalactites hanging some 30m above you as you surface in the middle of the island. The evening dive here creates some visually stunning photos as the light at the cavern entrance silhouettes big schools of fish.

Koh Phi Phi produces some beautiful dive sites, Giant gorgonian sea fans, Barrel sponges, Harp coral and Whip corals host many different species of fish. Swim through huge schools of Big Eyed snapper and watch when they scatter as Golden trevally dart into the middle of them, see the Small Tooth emperor change colour as they come down to feed off the reef. Getting to these dive sites in the early morning means we get there before any of the day boats, when marine life is just waking up giving us the chance to see many Black Tip reef sharks, Kuhls stingrays, Hawksbill turtles and more. A dive is also done on the Phi Phi wreck, teeming with life, the schools of fish here are so densely populated that at times you are not able to see the wreck. For the certified wreck divers amongst us this is a good chance to explore the inside, through narrow corridors, navigating around the lionfish.

The other wreck dive scheduled on this trip is the popular King Cruiser wreck, sunk in 1997 this wreck has become an artificial reef in itself. Now covered in white and purple hemprich soft corals you will get schools of fish sometimes in the thousands, Big eyed snapper, Yellow tail barracuda and Big Mouth mackerel all hang around this wreck, silhouetted in the openings, and you may also encounter schools of Pickhandle barracuda circling around.

Shark Point is one of the most beautiful of Phuket dive sites, the brightly coloured corals here are simply stunning and teeming with a diverse amount of marine life. Among the snapper, pufferfish, fusilier and angelfish you can also spot moray eels, shrimp, bamboo shark and even leopard sharks. This UNESCO site is a must visit site.

Marine Park Fee

All Scuba Explorer liveaboard trips include a marine park fee that goes exclusively to the conservation efforts for the marine park you are visiting, in this case the Koh Haa park benefits from your contribution and allows the Thailand government to police and regulate fishing activity in the area and keep an eye on Shark populations. The marine park fee is not included in the trip price, so please bring the correct amount with you on the cruise.

This trips marine park fee is:

Cruise Itinerary

The boat sets off from Patong pier traveling overnight arriving at a Phi Phi dive site on day 1. 2 dives are done at Phi Phi and one at the wreck before heading to Koh Lanta National Marine Park to dive Koh Haa in the evening with an optional night dive at nearby Koh Rok Noi. The next morning there are 2 dives on Hin Daeng and one on Hin Muang and Koh Haa before the boat travels back to Phi Phi for the optional night dive and an evening out on Phi Phi Don. The next day the boat heads back towards Phuket stopping of at King Cruiser and Shark Point for the last 2 dives of the trip.
